Bachelor of Emergency Management (120ch, 90ch) Diploma of Emergency Management <i>(to replace the existing Bachelor of Technology (Emergency Management))</i>	New	CBU is proposing to implement new online Emergency Management programs to replace its previous Bachelor of Technology (Emergency Management). Offerings would include a 45ch Diploma in Emergency Management, a 90ch Bachelor of Emergency Management and a 120ch Bachelor of Emergency Management Major in Health Emergency Management. Content includes between 10 (for the diploma) and 16 (for the Health Emergency Management Major) courses specifically in Emergency Management, along with others in related disciplines (e.g., Management, Communications, Public Health). Degree students are also required to complete a seven-month practicum experience.	Stage II	Approved with conditions (October 3, 2017)
Post-baccalaureate Diploma in Business Analytics	New	CBU is proposing to introduce a two-year, 39 credit, post-baccalaureate credential program aimed at students who have strong math skills and who are interested in pursuing concentrated studies in Business Analytics. Post-baccalaureate Diploma in Business Management	New	CBU is proposing to introduce a two-year, 39 credit, post-baccalaureate program intended to provide non-business graduates with a solid foundation in essential aspects of business, including accounting, marketing, finance, economics, and statistics. The program consists of ten required courses, two electives chosen from an approved list, and either a capstone project, or 12-week internship placement.	Stage I	Approved (October 20, 2017)
Post-baccalaureate Diploma in Supply Chain Management	New	CBU is proposing to introduce a two-year, 39 credit, post-baccalaureate program aimed at students who are interested in pursuing concentrated studies in Supply Chain Management. Students will gain practical insight into key aspects of supply chain management from a theoretical and practical perspective.
